A Thematic Statement should be expressed as a Declarative Sentence or Sentences. One should be careful to avoid using single statements like "love" or phrases like "Individual vs. Society.". These are subjects or topics, not themes. The theme is the author's idea about the topic.

As the main goal of a thematic essay prompt is to make the student respond to the specific questions, so give your answer at the end! Add a summary of the essay's topic. Paraphrase the main point, essay's thesis statement, share the findings and sum up how the included information helped to prove the author's opinion.

Whereas codes identify interesting information in your data, themes are broader and involve active interpretation of the codes and the data.
